Event Formats

Selecting the right event format for your participants will make your event an enjoyable success. By knowing the skill level of those playing in your event, the reason for the outing, and scoring options, you can customize your outing to be enjoyable for all those who participate. Popular formats include, but are not limited to:

Individual Stroke Play – This format allows each individual participant to play their own ball throughout their round. Smaller groups sizes with an experienced skill level prefer this format.

Scramble – All players tee off, the best-positioned shot is then selected and all players play from that point, this is repeated until a ball is holed. This format keeps the pace of play moving and allows for a wide range of ability levels to enjoy the course.

On-Course Events

These events provide the feeling of an event within the event. Popular on-course events include; closest to the pin, longest drive. With on-course events your participants will be challenged and captivated throughout their round of golf.

Event Amenities

As determined by your budget and desired level of services you may want to add some special value added compliments to your tournament. Make your event memorable for your participants with amenities such as an on-course beverage cart, hospitality areas, or instructional clinics. Amenity prices are subject to the level or service and limited only by the imagination.

Event Requirements

- Starting times are determined by the Golf Professional.
- Shotgun starts and tee times do not guarantee course exclusivity.
- 32 player minimum requirement for shotgun start.
- The University's 19th Hole Cafe must approve all food and beverage, purchased or donated.
- Events with more than 110 players may incur outside golf car rental fees of \$50 per car per day. Please keep in mind additional golf cars must be ordered at least one month in advance.
